

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## SHORELINE METRO PROPOSED FARE CHANGES TO SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

Notice is hereby given regarding a public hearing for:

- 1) Permanent fare **decrease** for ADA Paratransit service from \$3.50 to \$3.00 per one-way trip effective 1/1/21.
- 2) Permanent fare **increase** for County Elderly and Disabled Program service from \$2.50 to \$3.00 per one-way trip effective 1/1/21.

A public hearing is scheduled for **September 22, 2020 at 5:00pm** in the first floor conference room #106 at the Sheboygan City Hall, 828 Center Ave, Sheboygan, WI 53081. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

## PROPOSED FARE CHANGES TO SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS EFFECTIVE 1/1/2021

### CURRENT FARES:

- **ADA Paratransit** | **\$3.50** per one-way trip
- **County Elderly and Disabled Program** | **\$2.50**  
per one-way trip

### PROPOSED FARES:

- **ADA Paratransit** | **\$3.00** per one-way trip
  - **Decrease** of \$0.50 per trip
- **County Elderly and Disabled Program** | **\$3.00**  
per one-way trip
  - **Increase** of \$0.50 per trip

**GOAL:** To set one standard fare for all customers using specialized transit services provided by Metro Connection.
