

## PARKING BEST PRACTICES

The City of Sheboygan wants you to have an enjoyable experience while visiting our downtown including your parking experience. Please follow these tips and best practices for a positive parking experience.

### EVENT PARKING

Visitors attending events during the day on weekdays should use the on-street meters and available parking lot meters (see map on other side). Parking in other areas such as permit parking lots may result in a ticket. Please be mindful of the time limits on meters. Meters are available in 3-hour or 10-hour limits and each meter is individually labeled.

Visitors attending events during the evening and weekends may park at any on-street meter or available stalls in all public parking lots at no charge. Overnight parking is permitted; however vehicles must be removed by 8:00 a.m. on weekdays.

### PERSONAL PROPERTY

Visitors are reminded to lock their vehicles and secure personal belongings inside the vehicle. Lost or stolen items are the responsibility of the owner.

### METERED PUBLIC PARKING

Visitors may park at any available meter and pay for parking up to the indicated time limit. Failure to pay the required meter fee may result in a ticket.

### PARKING TICKETS & VIOLATIONS

Customers using a parking meter during normal operating hours are required to pay the meter fee. Failure to do so may result in a parking ticket of \$10. Customers parking in a permit parking lot during normal operating hours may be issued a ticket of \$25.

## RESERVED PERMIT PARKING

Reserved parking lots provide exceptional parking at a great value. All parking lots allowing for reserved parking will be referred to as permit parking. Customers may lease a permit for a specific lot and park at any available stall in that lot. The frustration of someone taking your parking stall is over. So is calling the police department to report the issue. Customers will enjoy the comfort of finding an available stall without the hassle and frustration associated with assigned parking stalls. The benefit of the On-Street Parking Permit is also included with this option. This is how parking is meant to be: easy and convenient.

### Off-Street Reserved Parking Permit - \$35/mon.

Parking lots included in this tier are:

- Lot 7 – 800 block of Center Avenue
- Lot 13 – 700 block of New York Avenue
- Lot 14 – 700 block of Niagara Avenue
- Lot 17 – 700 block of Niagara Avenue

### Off-Street Reserved Parking Permit - \$30/mon.

Parking lots included in this tier are:

- Lot 5 – 800 block of New York Avenue
- Lot 6 – 600 block of N 9<sup>th</sup> Street
- Lot 8 – 500 block of N 9<sup>th</sup> Street

### Off Street Reserved Parking Permit - \$25/mon.

Parking lots included in this tier are:

- Lot 2 – 800 block of Niagara Avenue

### Off Street Reserved Parking Permit - \$20/mon.

Parking lots included in this tier are:

- Lot 9 – 700 block of Pennsylvania Avenue

### Off Street Reserved Parking Permit - \$10/mon.

- Lot 3 – 800 block of Niagara Avenue

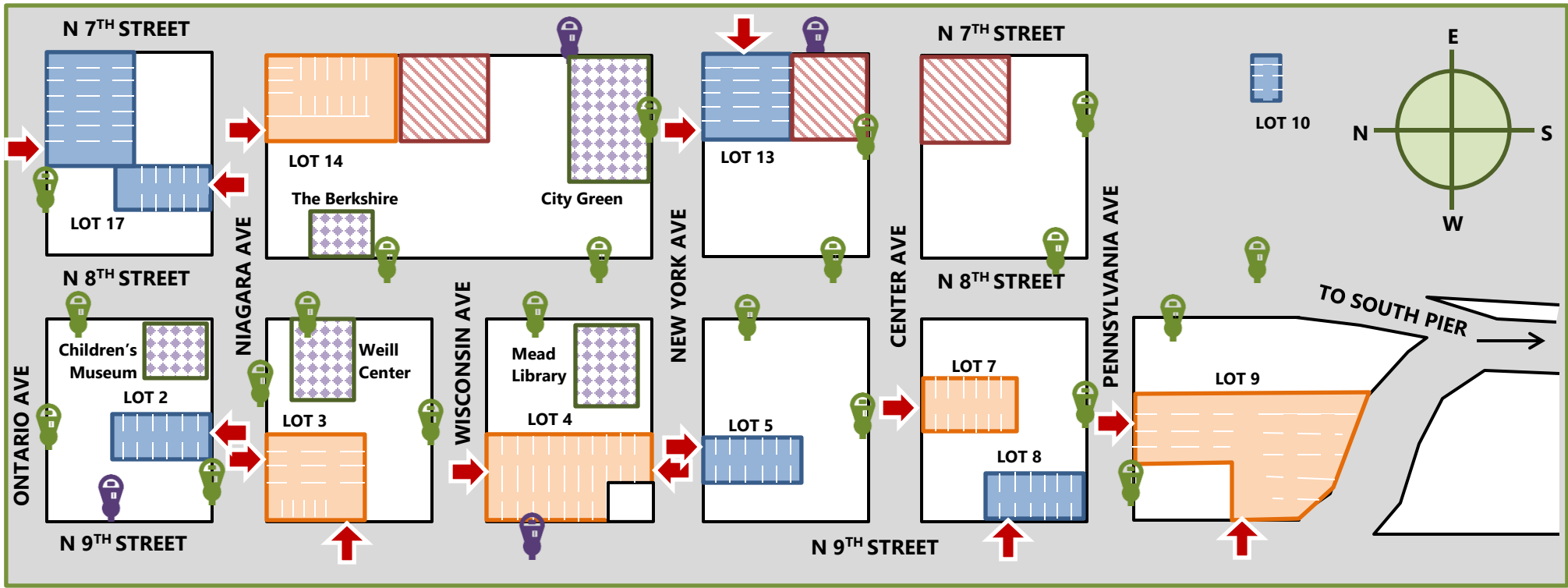

### OFF-STREET PUBLIC PARKING

Downtown Sheboygan provides quick, affordable and accessible off-street parking for customers and guests. The map above shows locations of public off-street parking. Please review the "key" below for more information on public parking:

-  *These lots are reserved permit parking only (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) Evenings and weekends are FREE parking in these lots.*
-  *These lots have general public parking at metered stalls only. Meters are 3 and 10 hour meters. All unmetered stalls are "permit parking only". All stalls are FREE parking during evenings and weekends.*
-  *Private parking lots not available for public parking.*
-  *Event venues in downtown Sheboygan.*

### METERED ON-STREET PUBLIC PARKING

Public metered parking is available on all streets in downtown Sheboygan. Meter rates are \$0.50 per hour with most meters allowing for 3-hour or 10-hour parking. Meters are enforced from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Evenings and weekends are FREE parking.

Individual meters are labeled for "15-minute" parking. Please reserve the use of these meters for short-term parking.

Individual meters are also labeled for "No Permit Parking". Please reserve the use of these meters for cash paying customers.
